April 2024 - Jesus Fulfilled the Law

The book of Hebrews was written to Jewish believers who seemed always on the verge of slipping back into their old ways of seeking to follow the law. The author of this book ultimately points them to Jesus Christ, "the founder and perfecter of their faith" who died once for all as their perfect sinless sacrifice as the blood of animals was not sufficient to save them from their sins. In Christ they have a Great High Priest who can sympathize with their weakness and tempted in every way they are, yet without sin. The subsequent books from James to Jude follow the practical overflow of our salvation in living the Christian life while not losing sight of our calling to holiness in the midst of a dark world that God will one day fully redeem.
