

# Extravagant Love Discussion Questions

Mark 14:1-9

1. The main theme of the sermon was to do all you can with what you have. Name five things that you have.
2. In what way can you use the five things you mentioned for God?
3. What does it mean to be broken and fully surrendered to the Lord? What would this look like in your life?
4. Pastor Brian mentioned that true love is always extravagant. Why is that? What about true love makes us do extravagant things?
5. In what extravagant ways are you demonstrating your commitment to Christ?
6. What is God asking you to do that might be considered radical?
7. Think of a time when you were criticized for what you were doing for God. How did that criticism make you feel? Did it affect your actions?
8. Think of a time when you were the person criticizing what someone else was doing for God. What made you be so critical and outspoken toward the other person?
9. On a scale of 1 to 5, 1 being not critical and 5 being very critical, where would you put yourself on this scale? Where would other people put you?
10. What can we do to move ourselves down on this scale and prevent us from being so critical and become more encouraging to others instead?
11. Describe how you think Mary's face, posture, and thoughts would have changed from the time she heard the criticism to when Jesus praised her.
12. When we love Jesus, we will love the little, the least and the lost. What is something you can do this week for one of these people?
13. Knowing what you have done for God since you have been a Christian, how do you think you will feel about it in Heaven? Do you think you will be surprised by the impact, disappointed by how little you did, etc. Why? Is there something you can do to change how you think you would feel to be more positive?
14. There is always a spiritual fragrance in the home and hearts where Jesus is loved and worshipped? How strong of a fragrance would your heart be giving off? Would it be a pleasant smell or a gross smell? Why?
