

Last Meal with the Master Discussion Questions

Mark 14:22-31

1. Communion celebrates the timeless deliverance that comes through the blood of the sinless Lamb of God. What has God delivered you from? (Be more specific than sins)
2. Each element of the Passover meal symbolized something of the past? Why was it important to remember the past?
3. What meaning does the title Bread of Life take on as you look at it in connection with communion and the Passover meal?
4. What does Mark 10:39 mean when it says, "The cup I drink you will drink?" Does this apply to us today? How or how not?
5. Why was it important for Jesus to "Shed His blood?"
6. What do we have to do with the blood Jesus shed? How does this relate to Passover?
7. When we take communion, what are we looking forward to? Why is this important?
8. Give an example of a time where you deserted Christ like the disciples did? What brought you back to Him?
9. Share a time when you were hesitating or didn't share about Christ to someone when you felt led to. Why did you hesitate or not share with them?
10. Have you ever made a statement in pride like Peter did and then did exactly what you said you won't do? How did you feel and how did you move past it?
11. Why is it important to remember what Jesus did for us?
12. Why is it good to do a personal evaluation every time we have communion?
13. How does reconciling with people fit into communion and Passover?
14. In what way has understanding the Passover meal and the different elements helped you to understand communion better?
15. What is the main thing you took away from the sermon and this discussion this week?
