2. What joy and comfort do you receive from knowing God?
3. How does it make you feel to know that God never changes?

5. We can't be God so we can't have all of His attributes, but we can become more like Him by gaining some of His attributes. What attributes do you have? What ones do you need to work on?
6. How does one observe or behold God?
7. Why would Isaiah believe it important for us to understand that God has measured everything in the universe and that no one can measure God?
8. How can God be knowable but incomprehensible at the same time?
9. How does not being able to fully comprehend God make us humble?
10. Is it possible for our faith to be strengthened by not being able to fully know God? Why or why not?
11. What does your picture of God look like currently? How has it changed as you have matured as a Christian?
12. How can our picture of God deceive us? Does your picture measure up with what the Bible says about God? Is there some adjusting you need to make?
13. What does creation reveal about God?
14. What are some things the Bible reveals about God?
15. What are a couple of your favorite characteristics about Jesus? What do these characteristics say about God?
16. Why is it better to boast about our understanding about and relationship with God than about wisdom, power, or wealth?
