7. Why is it we can't be good enough to get to heaven?
8. Which of the seven characteristics of God's love are you most grateful for? Why? Which is the most humbling? Why?
9. How do the following four descriptions of our condition before we came to Christ make you feel? Weak, ungodly, sinners, enemies. Which one hurts you the most? Why?
10. What is our condition since we came to Christ?
11. What are your thoughts when you consider the most beautiful places and things on earth are not as beautiful as they would be without the ugliness of sin affecting them? How does this inspire your imagination about what heaven will look like without sin?
12. Why would God send His Son to die for His enemies and why would Jesus be willing to do it? What does this say to you about God's love for you and others?
13. How does the following statement after your view of God's love on your life: "If God love me enough to give His Son when I was His enemy, surely He love me enough to care for me now that I am His child."
14. How are you going demonstrate your love for God to Him?
15. Which of the responses that Brian gave is the hardest for you to do? Why? Which is the easiest? Why?
16. What does it mean to you for God to love you no matter what you have done or how you have lived? What does it mean to you that you are treasured despite your transgressions?
17. Do you feel like you are worth His love, time, and attention? Why or why not?
18. Do you find it easy or difficult to lean on God? Why?
