9. How is the Bible beneficial for us today?
10. How can Christians speak truth about sin, but show grace to the sinner?
11. Why did Jesus attend synagogue on a regular basis? Do you think His reasons apply to us today? If He went, do you think we should also make it a priority to attend church? Why or why not?
12. How can reading the Bible embolden you to share the gospel with others?
13. How does applying the Bible embolden you to share the gospel with others?
14. Why does heeding the commands and warnings of the Bible embolden us?
15. What happens to us if we feel like we don't need the Bible anymore?
