

Mission Possible Discussion Questions

Acts 1:6-11

September 21-22, 2019

1. What does it mean to be a witness? What is expected from them?
2. Jesus often talked about the future kingdom of God, but He wants the disciples to focus on the present. Is it good to think about the Second Coming and Heaven? Why must we focus on the present? How do we know when we are too caught up in the future?
3. How are you proclaiming the Word of God at work? At home? At activities you attend? Etc.
4. Why did the disciples have to wait for the Holy Spirit to start? How do we know when we are using the power of the Holy Spirit or our own?
5. What is the difference between bearing witness and being a witness?
6. What is your witness communicating to those around you?
7. What does an ambassador do? How are you being an ambassador of Christ? Are you doing a good job?
8. Does knowing it is not your job to persuade or defend the gospel, but to simply report what you have experienced and know to be true make it easier to be a witness or harder? Why ?
9. Does the idea of failing or messing up in witnessing keep you from witnessing? Did you know that you don't need to fear this? Why don't we need to fear failing in witnessing?
10. Where and when are we to be witnesses?
11. The Jews hated the Samaritans, but God included them in His instructions. Who is your enemy, or the person you dislike, or the person you have been avoiding ? How are you witnessing to them?
12. Have you ever thought that maybe some of the difficulties you go through are providing a way for you to witness? How can our difficulties help us to witness?
13. What are you doing to spread the gospel to the world? What are some ways you can increase this impact.
14. How did you bless someone this past week? What are your plans for the coming week?
