1. Who have you BLESSED this week and how did you do it?
2. What do you think of when you hear or use the phrase "I want to know what God's will is for my life?"
3. What decisions are you facing right now?
4. Why is it important to obey immediately? What can happen if we don't?
5. How is delaying to obey really disobedience?
6. Read Acts 1:12-26. Is it easy to persevere in praying? Why or why not? What makes it hard to persevere in praying? What makes it easy to persevere?
7. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17 & Romans 12:12. What does it mean to "devote yourself to prayer?" How do we pray continually or be constant in prayer?
8. Do you read the Bible daily? If so, why do you do it and how does it help you? What difference do you notice when you miss a day or so? If you don't read on a daily basis, what keeps you from it? What can you do to get yourself motivated to do it and keep yourself accountable?
9. How does asking, "What does the Bible say," help you to make wise decisions?
10. How has God "make a way" for you with the decisions you have made in the past?
11. How does declaring the need, delineate the options, declaring through prayer help you to decide what is best?
12. Have you used the ten questions from Proverbs to make decisions? If so, how have they helped you? Which of these questions has helped you the most or you think will help you the most to make wise decisions?
13. What does it mean to lean on the Lord? How do you lean on the Lord?
14. How do we learn to love some one? How do we learn to love the Lord with everything we are?
15. How has God led you in the past? How is He leading you now? How does this help you to follow Him in the future?
