Acts 2:44-47

October 26-27, 2019

1. Pastor Brian said in the sermon "If you unplug, you will unravel." What did he mean by this statement? Have you experienced this for yourself? Briefly explained what happened to you.
2. Read Hebrews 10:24-25. Go around the room and share how each person in the group helps you, or encourages, or why you look forward to them being present.
3. What is the benefit of gathering in a large more formal group such as a weekend worship service?
4. What is the benefit of gathering in a smaller more informal group such as a growth group?
5. Read Acts 2:44-45 and Acts 4:34-35. Why did the early Christians sell their possessions? What blessings did they get from doing this? What do you think this would do for their relationships?
6. Why is it important to lightly hold on to our possessions? How do we know if we are holding on too tight to our possessions?
7. Is there anything that fits this description in your life? What do you need to do to lighten your hold?
8. What is the difference between my ownership and God's ownership?
9. Since God owns the possessions you have, what should you do if God is leading you to give it away or do something different with it? Why is this sometimes hard for us to do?
10. How does looking and saying stuff is God's make it easier to do what God wants with it? How does this put us in our proper place? What does this require of us?
11. What fear keeps us from giving away more of our possessions and money?
12. Read Acts 2:46. What should our response be for everything God entrusts to us?
13. Read 2 Corinthians 9:7. According to this verse, how are we to give? Why is it important to follow this verse? What happens when we don't? If we can't give the way this verse describes, what should we do?
