11. What attitude should Christians have that would encourage an atmosphere of public confession and repentance?
12. When someone else confesses and is treated with respect, would that reaction help you to confess? Why or why not?
13. What benefit can come when someone confesses publicly?
14. How often do we need to repent? Why?
15. Read Romans 2:4. How does God lead us to repentance? Is repentance something we can do apart from God?
16. What does it mean to be released from our sins?
17. Read Isaiah 43:25. What happens when God blots out our sins?
