1. Read Isaiah 64:1. Do you feel like Isaiah in longing for the Lord to come back? Why or why not?
2. Have you said "Here am I, send me" to the Lord? If yes, what happened next? If no, what is preventing you from saying it?
3. Tell of a time when someone was warning you that you were not following God? How did you respond to the person at the time and how did you respond to the message? Did this help you?
4. Have you had to be the person to warn someone else, they were not following God? How did you approach it? How did it go? What did you learn from it?
5. Read Isaiah 7:14. How has God worked in your life despite your disobedience?
6. Describe an event where you saw God work that gave you a certainty about God and what He is doing?
7. Why is it important that Mary's pregnancy was different from all other women?
8. Read John 1:14 & 2 Corinthians 5:21. How is Jesus fully man and fully God at the same time?
9. Of the prophecies that were fulfilled by Christ's incarnation, which one means the most to you? Why?
10. What is the significance of Matthew starting with Isaiah 7:14 and the way he ends it in Matthew 28:20?
11. What reactions have you witnessed from people to the gospel? Share one experience and how that affects your witnessing now?
12. Read 1 Timothy 1:15. Why did God become one of us? Do you view yourself the same way? Why or why not?
13. Read Revelation 21:3. Why would God want to dwell with us and want us as His people and to be our God?
