3. How would the signs verify the message of the gospel?
4. Does God use signs like these today? Why or why not? If so, what are their purpose?
5. Why did the early church gather together so often? What did they gain by doing so? Do we have that today?
6. What do we miss when we don't gather with God's people on a regular basis?
7. Read Acts 5:12-16. Who were the "rest" that did not dare to join them? What would be some reasons for this?
8. How did the early church gain a good reputation in the community?
9. What kind of reputation do you think Edgewood has in the community? What can we do to gain a better reputation?
10. What kind of positive impact have we had to change the community we live in?
11. Have you ever led anyone to the Lord? If so, how do you feel when God has used you to help point someone to Christ? If not, what do you think is the reason for this?
12. What hurt are you carrying with you today? Have you given it to the Lord to help heal you?
13. Are you afraid to let others know about it? Why?
14. In the past, how has someone with a similar hurt to yours helped you through the pain?
15. How can revealing your hurt lead others to help you and for you to be able to help others?
