3. How can we tell when someone is full of the Holy Spirit?
4. What do we mean when we say someone is full of faith? Or full of grace?
5. How do we become men and women full of the Holy Spirit, wisdom, faith, grace and power?
6. What is courage? Why do we need it as Christians?
7. How do we become more courageous in our Christianity?
8. Read Luke 21:12-15. What does persecution lead to? Why does Jesus tell us not to worry about what we are going to say? Is this easy for you or hard for you to do?
9. Share about a time when you asked God to help you witness to someone. How did God help you in that situation?
10. How do you react to lies you encounter? Why is it important to handle them correctly? How should we handle them?
11. What was the Law of Moses? Why was it important? What do we learn from it?

13. Why don't we offer sacrifices today? Who is our sacrifice?
