5. What is your reaction to the statement, “God is for you!”?
6. Read Psalm 118:6. How does viewing God on your side, change your feelings and attitude about your opposition?
7. What does it mean to you that God the Father gave His only Son for you?
8. If He was willing to pay that price, what would He not be willing to do for your good? Why?
9. Of the different directions we can feel attacked from, which one do you feel most attacked by? Why is this?
10. When you are feeling attacked, what can you remind yourself of? How does this help you?
11. How does Jesus intercede for you?
12. How can we live as if “the devil was disarmed and defeated on the cross”?
13. What does it mean to you to know that Jesus is praying for you?
14. Have you ever felt like God was displeased with you? What made you feel like this?
15. Can you do anything to make God stop loving you? Why?
16. Does God still love us when we are in trials? Since He loves us, what could be some of the reasons He allows us to go through difficulties?
