1. List groups of people that often go unseen by us. Why so we do that? How can we change?
2. In what ways are you currently helping orphans and vulnerable children?
3. How have you been brave like Shiphrah and Puah in standing up for the preborn? Is there something you could do right now to demonstrate this kind of courage?
4. What does it mean to fear God? To what extent are you fearing God? Does it keep you from sinning and motivate you to serve?
5. What situations can lead someone to seek an abortion or to place their child for adoption? What can we do to help these people and their extended families?
6. Do you know of anyone who is a foster parent or an adoptive parent? Do you see a need they may have? What can you do to meet that need?
7. Is there something you can do to help Safe Families for Children?
8. What are you doing to make a faith impact on the children around you?
9. How can the little things we do for someone make a huge impact on others? Do we always know when this happens?
10. Read Deuteronomy 10:18, Psalm 68:5, Micah 6:8, Matthew 25:40, Romans 8:15 and James 1:27. What are these verses telling us to do?
11. How would you define a habit? Are you in the habit of helping people, especially those mentioned in the above verses?
12. Could God be calling you to foster or adopt? Why or why not? Are your answers just excuses or are they valid?
13. Pray for God to give you opportunities to help orphans and vulnerable children. Pray also for those who are fostering, seeking to adopt, or have adopted children.
