1. How are you being salt and light in the world today?
2. What did you think about the statistic about 66% of Christians using Facebook daily, but not reading their Bible daily? Do you fit the statistic? What changes does this statistic motivate you to make?
3. How has this pandemic influence you to share the gospel? Is this a positive or negative response?
4. Why is persecution promised to every believer? Read John 15:20 and 2 Timothy 3:12.
5. Is there anyone or group you are treating the way Jews did the Samaritans? If so, who and what is your first step in changing this attitude?
6. Have you become too comfortable in your Christian life? Why or why not? What is God prodding you to do outside of your comfort zone?
7. Read Luke 21:10-13. How can you use the problems you are facing or have faced to proclaim the gospel?
8. Read Acts 11:19-21, 12:24, 19:20. What happened as a result of being scattered and preaching the Word? How have you seen this in your own life?
9. How can we be a bridge instead of a barrier to the gospel?
10. What does a person have to have in order to influence someone else? How do we obtain this with them? How can we use this influence to spread the gospel? Will this be an easy or difficult process? Will it be short or a long process? Why?
11. How did God use ordinary people in the Bible? If he did this with them, can He do this with you? What must you be willing to do so God can use you?
12. How does proclaiming God's Word unleash His power? What do we do when we see this happen? Briefly share a personal experience along these lines.
13. Why does prosperity cause inertia?
14. How are you going to show love and grace to those around you this week?
15. What bridges do you plan to build with people this week?
