1. How have you used technology to share the gospel with others?
2. What would be your Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the ends of the earth? How have you been reaching out to your “Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the ends of the earth?”
3. Who does God want you to go to and reach out to them?
4. Have you ever been doing something that was important for God’s work, like Philip with the revival, and you felt God leading you somewhere else? What conflicts of emotions did you have? If you haven’t, how do you think you would have felt given Philip’s position and responsibilities?
5. What has God done for you during times He has you in a “remote” time in your life? What purpose did this “remote” time have in your life?
6. Have there been times you have not responded to God’s prompting in your life? How did this make you feel later? What did you do about it?
7. How can we make sure to hear and obey God’s promptings in our life, so we don’t miss more opportunities?
8. Have you experience a divine intersection in your life? Briefly describe what occurred.
9. What would it look like to “cleave, glue, and cement yourself to someone?” What are some things you can do to get closer to the person you are reaching out to?
10. What are some excuses we use to avoid spending more time with someone? Are these excuses valid? Why or Why not? What can you do to make sure you aren’t just using an excuse and doing what God wants you to do?
11. What is the difference between obedience and enthusiastic obedience?
12. How much time do you spend around non-Christians? Does this amount need to change in order to have more of a spiritual impact on them? How does proximity to non-Christians help to spread the gospel?
13. How does asking questions provide information we need to know about people to help them understand the gospel?
14. Which one of the three skills of evangelism are you good at and which one do you feel needs to become stronger? Why? What can you do to make it stronger?
15. Which of the questions to ask do you think will be helpful for you in sharing the gospel?
16. How are you at witnessing every place you go?
