1. Read Revelation 2:4-5 and 2 Chronicles 7:14. What did you use to do when you first became a Christian? How has that changed? What do you need to return to?
2. Take time to seek God, repent, and pray for healing for our land.
3. What benefits to week receive from regular exercise?
4. What are some spiritual exercises we need to do on a regular basis to grow?
5. How are you doing at being with other disciples? What creative things are you doing to gather with God's people?
6. Read Acts 9: 20-22. Who are you telling about Jesus? Why do you do this? If you don't, why don't you?
7. Do you feel like you don't know enough to share the Gospel? If so, what can you do to learn more? Can you still share the Gospel even if you don't know that much? Who can help you share the Gospel and answer questions?
8. Read 2 Timothy 3:12. What opposition have you faced while trying to share the Gospel with others?
9. Read Acts 9:23-25. Do you know a brother or sister in Christ that needs help of some kind? What can you do to help them?
10. What was people's reaction to the news of your salvation? Where people surprised, skeptical, thrilled, etc. What feelings did you have when going to church for the first time? What made you feel comfortable and accepted?
11. How can you be an encouragement to someone else who may me struggling? How can you help them grow and feel more comfortable and accepted?
12. Take time to pray for our Go team Partners and ask God if there is more He wants you to do to support their ministries?
