3. Read Acts 12:21-22. In what ways was Herod looking for glory from the people? Do you think the people really respected him?
4. In what ways are you like Herod and seek glory for yourself? How do you respond when people praise you?
5. Read Exodus 20:5, Leviticus 10:1-2, Deuteronomy 4:24, Isaiah 42:8, Isaiah 48:11, Psalm 115:1. What do these verses tell us about God and His glory?
6. What are some things people do that take glory from God?
7. Read Proverbs 16:8. What happens to people when they take glory for themselves?
8. How much time do you spend giving glory to God? What are some ways we can give Him glory in public and in private?
9. What are some benefits of giving God glory in public?
10. What benefit does acknowledging God's glory have for us?
11. How do you respond when someone has done something to tarnish your reputation? How does God respond when someone tries to tarnish His reputation?
12. In what ways has God had to humble you when you have become too prideful?
13. Read Isaiah 55:10-11. Can anything stop the spread of the gospel to others? Why or why not?
14. How has God positioned you to tell someone the gospel?
15. What does it mean to live by faith?
16. Read 1 Corinthians 10:31. What does this verse tell us to do? How can we put this verse into action?
17. Is there anything you are doing that does not bring glory to God? What are you going to do about it?
18. Why must you be completely surrendered to live for the glory of God? Are you completely surrendered to Him?
19. What does it mean that God is a jealous God? (Exodus 20:5, Deuteronomy 4:24)
20. Does anyone escape the consequences of sin? Why or why not?
