2. Why is friendship an important part of discipleship?
3. How do experiences help build friendships?
4. How do friends who are different from us help us become better people?
5. How have you seen God providentially work through people in your life to accomplish His purposes?
6. How can you use your workplace as a platform for ministry? Who is one person you can reach out to with the gospel? How can you go about doing this? What are some of your concerns about doing this?
7. How can you worship God through your work?
8. How has God blessed you financially in your life? Has there been a time God provided for you when the money was not there? How did He work? How has God moved you to help someone financially? How did you know God wanted you to give? Were you reluctant or hesitant in giving? Why or why not?
9. How can you form a relationship with one of your neighbors you do not currently know very well?
10. Has fear ever kept you from sharing the gospel? What fear did you have? If you could do anything to change this situation, what would you tell yourself that would encourage you to share the gospel? What plan do you have for defeating this fear in future opportunities?
11. When you look at the way God used government officials in the Bible, what did that usually mean for the Christians at the time? Does this make you afraid to ask God to use government officials? Why or why not?
12. When Christians had to leave their homes due to persecution, what happened to the gospel? Are you ready to face persecution? What can you do to help prepare yourself to face persecution if it comes to you?
13. Where are some places you go on a regular basis? How can you use these places for ministry?
14. How can you help strengthen other Christians?
15. Who are you currently discipling? How is this helping you in your faith? What benefits have come from this relationship?
16. Can you trace your decision to come to Christ back to someone else deciding to disciple another person like Apollos, Priscilla and Aquila, Paul, to Ananias? Could you share this with us?
