1. What do you think gospel centered living means?
2. What would people looking in at your life say is the thing you center your life around? Why would they say this? What do you spend most of your time outside of work doing?
3. Do you make it a priority to gather at church once a week? Why do you make this a priority or why don't you make this a priority?
4. Read Galatians 6:2. How do we "bear one another's burdens?"
5. Read James 5:16. What does James tell us to do? Why do we need to do this? For whom are you praying?
6. Have you ever confessed your sins to someone else? If so, how did this help?
7. How do you worship the Lord daily?
8. Read Hebrews 4:12 and Romans 1:16-17. What kind of power does the Word of God have?
9. Read 2 Timothy 3:16. What does God's word do for us?
10. How has your small group encouraged you? How has people from the church encouraged you?
11. How has your small group helped you to grow as a Christian?
12. Do you give to God's work financially? Why or why not? If so, how have you seen God work through what you have given and in your life?
13. Do you give of your time to God's work? If so, how do you give of your time? How have you been blessed and encouraged by it? If not, what do you think you would be interested in giving your time to? What is keeping you from giving your time?
14. What talents has God given you? What things do you enjoy doing? How can you use these talents for God's work?
15. Read Matthew 28:18-20. What does God tell us to do in this passage? How are you fulfilling it?
16. Will you commit to gathering for worship service? Will you commit to attending a small group regularly? Will you commit to reading God's Word daily? Will you commit to give of your finances, time, and talents? Will you commit to pray for a missionary? Will you consider going yourself to a mission field? Will you partner with one of our Go Team Partners? Will you commit to sharing the gospel with you lost loved ones and friends?
17. If you committed to any of the above, what are you going to do to be able to follow through with it? To whom are you going to be accountable?
18. Take time to pray for the lost, for our missionaries, for those you are going to reach out to with the gospel, for those in your group, and for yourself for the commitments you have made.
