1. Does knowing Christ is coming back soon make you want a closer relationship to the Lord? Why or why not?
2. What are some things you don't want to be doing when Christ comes back? What are some things you want to be doing when He comes back? How can you make it more likely to be doing the good things when He returns?
3. Does knowing prophecy and what God tells us is coming help increase your faith? If so, how?
4. What are some things we should be doing while we are waiting for His Second Coming?
5. Read Matthew 24:4-14. What are you seeing occurring in the world in relationship to the following signs?
 - Deception by false Christs
 - Disputes and warfare among nations
 - Disease and famine worldwide
 - Deliverance of believers to persecution
 - Defection of false believers
 - Declaration of the gospel to the whole world.
6. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 and 2 Corinthians 5:8. What comfort do these verses give regarding a loved one who knows Christ that has passed away? Do they provide comfort for you regarding your own death? Why or why not?
7. How does Jesus' death, resurrection, and return to Heaven provide a guarantee to Christians?
8. Besides being with Jesus, what part of the Rapture are you looking forward to the most?
9. Do you think the noise from Jesus' command, the voice of the archangel, and the trumpet will be terrifying? Why or why not?
10. What are the unbelievers who have died left in their graves? What is the Great White Throne judgment and who is it for?
11. How should thinking about the Rapture influence what we are doing right now?
12. Does talk of prophecy and the rapture comfort and encourage you or does it frighten you? Why?
13. Do you have priorities to adjust? Is there a secret sin you need to stop? Is there something you need to start doing?
14. Who can you encourage this week by talking to them about the Second Coming of Jesus Christ? Who do you need to tell so they will be ready to meet Him? Are you ready to meet Him?
