4. Why is unity among believers important? What does it say about us?
5. What harm comes from division among believers? Why is this an affective weapon Satan uses against us?
6. The disciples were faithful in spreading the Word, are you being faithful in spreading the Word? How are you spreading the Word to others?
7. Who are we to be at one with? Does this include the past, present, and future? How is this possible?
8. How does all our different gifts, abilities, personalities, thoughts, and opinions work together in unity?
9. How does a divided Christian community deny, by its behavior, the message it proclaims?
10. How does the way we act display God's reputation to the world? Are you portraying a positive or negative image of God's reputation?
