4. How do we empty God's name of meaning?
5. Read Titus 1:16 and Romans 2:24. How does a hypocrite take God's name in vain by the way the person is living?
6. Of the fifteen ways mentioned in the sermon to watch our lips, which ones are you planning on working on in your life?
7. How do you respond to people who use God's name in vain? Is this response appropriate? Why or why not? Can you come up with a better response?
8. What does hallow mean? How do we hallow God's name?
9. How does revering God's name and worshipping His majesty help us not to take His name in vain?
10. How was Job able to say "The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD" in Job 1:21? Are you able to do the same when you are going through difficult times? When God doesn't give you what you want?
11. Why is it important to monitor the movies you watch and the things you listen to? What do you do when you hear God's name taken in vain in a movie you are watching or something you are listening to?
12. How is complaining an assault on the Almighty?
13. Read Matthew 15:19, Revelation 2:17, and 2 Corinthians 5:17. How are we a new creature when we follow Jesus? How have you changed since you have accepted Christ? How is He still working in you today?
