3. Read Job 12:10. How does murder assume the authority of God?
4. Where do we get our value? How valuable are we? Do you feel you are valuable? Why or why not?
5. How is murder different from the other nine commandments?
6. What must we beware of with our anger? What do we need to do with our anger?
7. Read Matthew 5:21-22. How is anger with someone equal to murder?
8. How does devaluing life lead to horrible acts such as the Holocaust? What is the progression that takes place?
9. How do you feel to know that God not only made you, but knew you and set you apart for a purpose before you were born? What does this say about the value God puts on life in the womb?
10. Have you ever contemplated suicide? If so, what caused you to think such thoughts? What prevented you from committing suicide? What helped you? If not, have you ever helped someone who has contemplated suicide? What did you do?
11. How do some people justify euthanasia? Why is it important for us not to justify it? What could be some of the purposes God may have for someone to remain on earth even though they are suffering? What value does that person still have?
12. How is loving your neighbor a way of keeping the sixth commandment?
13. How are racism and prejudice breaking the sixth commandment?
14. Read Ezekiel 33:8-9. How is refusing to share the gospel a type of murder? How is sharing the gospel a way of rescuing the person?
