1. Who do you think would be first in rank spiritually? Where do you think you would be ranked? What can you do to be greater for God?
2. What is greatness in God's standards?
3. Who has had an impact on your spiritual life? Who do you feel you have spiritually impacted?
4. What little things do you do that seem not to have any significance?
5. How do people use their authority for selfish purposes?
6. What do you feel are your strengths? How can you use your strengths to help and build others up? If you have authority, how can you use it to build others up?
7. What does a servant's heart look like? What attitude do they have? Do you have a servant's heart? Why or why not?
8. How are you serving others? What joy do you receive from serving? If you aren't serving, what is something that interests you which you would consider serving in? What is preventing you from serving?
9. Which Bible character do you relate to that preferred the shadows? What about the Bible character do you admire? What was his/her weakness? How did he/she overcome his/her weakness.
10. How did Jesus treat people? Give an example. How are you treating others the same way? How or with whom do you need to improve in this area?
11. What price have you paid to serve others? Would you do it again? Why or why not? What makes paying the price worth it?
12. What spiritual gifts do you have? If you don't know, ask the people around you what they think you are gifted with? How are you using each of your spiritual gifts for God?
13. What are you passionate about? What are you good at doing? How can you use these for God?
14. How would you describe your personality? How has your personality helped you to serve God?
15. What experience do you have that God has used to impact others?
