1. In what ways do you find the doctrine of God's providence comforting?
2. Why do you think we often put missionaries on a pedestal? What negative effect does this have on them and on us?
3. Think about a sharp disagreement you've had with another believer. Is there anything you wish you would have done differently? Is there anything you can do now? What verses come to mind related to biblical peacemaking?
4. How do you think Mark felt after deserting Paul and Barnabas? What do you think would have happened had Barnabas not reached out to him? How do you handle your regrets?
5. Read Genesis 50:20. Describe a situation in which God brought good out of something that was bad.
6. Is there someone you know who is sitting on the spiritual sidelines? What one thing will you do this week to reach out?
7. In what ways have your grandparents influenced you? Why did God give grandparents such an important role in the faith formation of their grandchildren?
8. Have you ever been discipled? Are you discipling someone right now? If not, why not?
9. Discuss this statement: *"If you say you must know everything before you'll go anywhere, you'll end up going nowhere and doing nothing."* Give an example where this has been true in your life.
10. How can you see your neighbors as crying out for help? How can you grow in your love for the needs of lost people around the world?
11. In what ways can you reengage in serving this fall? What steps will you take?
