

On Sunday evening, August 6, 2017, Edgewood Baptist Church conducted a special business meeting to discuss next steps for facility stewardship.

Pastor Brian opened the meeting with a summarization of what our building costs were when built and what the cost would be if built today. He reviewed how our ministries have grown from 2013 to present. Using graphs he showed how our offerings have increased and how much we have in our Reserve Fund.

Dale Steele, Deacon Board Chairman, made a motion and it was seconded to consider the proposal of the Deacon Board to approve spending \$85,900 from the Reserve Fund for the Alignment Phase of a facility stewardship project with the Aspen Group.

Jason Crosby, Dale Steele, Pastor Brian Bill, and Steve Curry answered questions from the members about the proposal.

A motion was made and seconded to take a vote on the proposal.

Members were given ballots and asked to vote.

The meeting was closed in prayer by Pastor Ed Kuriscak.

The proposal passed with 264 "Yes" votes. There were 10 "No" votes.
