Psalm 34:4

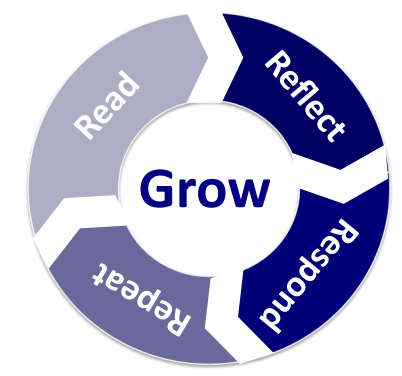
The Psalms express the heart of man to the God of the heart in poetic fashion. Both joys and frustrations are expressed to God who invites us to have confidence in Him.
