1. May [I's life be marked by grace, mercy, and peace - "Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord." (2 Timothy 1:2) 2. Motivate people to pray consistently and continually for [**]** – *"I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day.*" (2 Timothy 1:3) 3. Fill people with joy when they think of [] - "As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy." (2 Timothy 1:4)] to a saving and sincere faith through the vibrant faith of his 4. Draw [parents and grandparents - "I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well." (2 Timothy 1:5)5. Unleash your purposes in [I's life as he continually fans the flame of faith and uses his spiritual gifts for your glory – "For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God..." (2 Timothy 1:6)] the ability to live with power, love, and self-control and not 6. Stir within [**be paralyzed by fear or timidity** – "For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and *self-control.*" (2 Timothy 1:7)] to live unashamed of the Lord Jesus even if it means suffering for 7. Fortify [the gospel – "Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord, nor of me his prisoner, but share in suffering for the gospel by the power of God." (2 Timothy 1:8) 8. Save [] from his sins and set him apart for a lifetime of holy service for your glory and the growth of your kingdom – "Who saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works but because of His own purpose and grace..." (2 Timothy 1:9) 9. Grant [] the tenacity to guard and to share the good deposit entrusted to him – "By the Holy Spirit who dwells within us, guard the good deposit entrusted to you." (2 Timothy 1:14) 10. Strengthen [] by your grace when he feels weak and discouraged - "You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus." (2 Timothy 2:1) 11. As you call [] to be your disciple, use him to be a discipler of others - "And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others as well." (2 Timothy 2:2) 12. Bestow upon [] focused obedience, faithful diligence, and patient **endurance** – "No soldier gets entangled in civilian pursuits, since his aim is to please the one who enlisted him. An athlete is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules. It is the hardworking famer who ought to have the first share of the crops." (2 Timothy 2:4-6) 13. Deepen [I's desire to understand and embrace biblical beliefs and godly **behavior** – "Think over what I say, for the Lord will give you understanding in everything." (2 Timothy 2:7) 14. Give [] a winsome spirit and keep him from quarreling about words as you ground him in your Word – "Remind them of these things and charge them before God not to quarrel about words, which does no good, but only ruins the hearers." (2 Timothy 2:14) 15. Train [] to be an approved worker who rightly handles your Word as he teaches it to the world around him – "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15) 16. Instill within [] a desire for purity, godliness, and holy living - "Let everyone who names the name of the Lord depart from iniquity...if anyone cleanses himself from what is dishonorable, he will be a vessel for honorable use, set apart as holy...so flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure

heart." (2 Timothy 2:19-22)

17. Fill [] with the fruit of kindness by giving him the ability to teach and correct with gentleness – "And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, correcting his opponents with gentleness..." (2 Timothy 2:24-25)

- 18. Anchor [] to your Word so that he can withstand challenges to his faith "But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty." (2 Timothy 3:1)
- 19. Empower [] to not just have the appearance of godliness but to be godly in his thoughts, attitudes, words, and behavior "Having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power." (2 Timothy 3:5)
- 20. **Give** [] **mentors to follow so he will have models of godliness in his life** "You, however, have followed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness, my persecutions, and sufferings..." (2 Timothy 3:10-11)
- 21. Enable [] to not be surprised by suffering and to endure any persecution that comes his way – "Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted." (2 Timothy 3:12)
- 22. Immerse and equip [] with the Scriptures and save him at an early age so he will be firm in his faith as he gets older – "But as for you, continue in what you have learned and firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus." (2 Timothy 3:14-15)
- 23. May [] love your Word, so he learns it and lives it out "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness." (2 Timothy 3:16)
- 24. Grow [] to be a mature man of God who is equipped to live on mission for the sake of his neighbors and the nations "That the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." (2 Timothy 3:17)
- 25. Embolden [] to preach your Word with urgency and with the expectation that you will use it to grow him and others – "Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching." (2 Timothy 4:2)
- 26. **Guard and protect** [] from false teaching and easy believism "For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions." (2 Timothy 4:3)
- 27. Stir within [] a white-hot devotion to you so he is able to endure suffering while doing the work of an evangelist "As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry." (2 Timothy 4:5)
- 28. Allow [] the joy of pouring himself out in service for you "For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come." (2 Timothy 4:6)
- 29. **Fill] with your Spirit so he will fight the good fight, finish his race, and keep the faith until you call him to yourself** – *"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith."* (2 Timothy 4:7)
- 30. Keep before [] the certainty of future rewards so he lives faithfully for you in the present – "Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that Day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing." (2 Timothy 4:8)
- 31. May [] live out the gospel for your glory alone "The Lord will rescue me from every evil deed and bring me safely into his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen." (2 Timothy 4:18)
