April 2025 - Fulfilling the Law

Old and New Testament books often parallel one another as the writers of the church age understood that Jesus came to fulfill the law, not abolish it. They would often quote the OT as well as reference historical Biblical characters as examples of faith who were looking forward to a future Messiah who would one day rule and reign as king. The book of Exodus introduces us to Moses, the greatest OT prophet, who God uses to lead his people out of Egypt. Through miraculous signs and wonders, His people are set free and given the law so they might know what God requires of them. Through ups and downs and God's mercy and judgment, the children of Israel begin to understand their relationship with God and how they will be set apart as holy from the nations around them. The foreshadowing of the One who is to come is evident in the OT, and the NT writers verify this over and over again. Jesus, our prophet, priest, and king, fulfilled all the requirements of the law and died as our perfect, sinless substitute so that we need only trust and follow Him.
