February 2025 - In the Beginning, God...

These words may be the most important in all the Bible as they establish that before anything ever was, there was God. This one fact lays the foundation for the rest of Scripture in that God's existence establishes that there is a Creator, and we are not products of random chance or natural processes. The book of Genesis along with other select passages show us who God is, and that Jesus is the Creator and Sustainer of all things, and He alone is worthy of worship. It also shows us who we are, that we are made in God's image, yet because of the Fall, we are sinners in need of a Savior that Jesus alone has the power to save. Genesis begins *The Story* (weaving itself all the way to Revelation) that introduces us to Abraham who will be the father of a great nation, the children of Israel. And in and through this family "all the families of the earth will be blessed." From the beginning, God promised to establish a family that would grow to be as numerous as the stars of heaven and we are part of that promise.
