We could all use more joy in our lives. When we get caught up in the cares of this world, the busyness of life, and the struggle with personal sin, we often forget the joy we possess as believers. As followers of Jesus, we have more cause for joy than anyone else on earth because of the Hope we have that comes from a relationship with God, our Creator. Paul understood this well, even as he wrote to the church at Philippi from prison. The book of Philippians is more joy-filled than any other book despite the circumstances of its origin. Paul's surrendered faith was so strong that even a prison cell and chains could not keep him from rejoicing in the Lord. There are many other passages (especially in the OT) that remind us of the joy we have and that nothing can take it from us.
