May 2025 - On Mission

The book of Matthew is the first book of the New Testament, focusing on the Kingdom of God and Jesus as Messiah. It begins with the genealogy of Jesus Christ and culminates in the Great Commission after His death and resurrection, proving His message and His deity. Like the other three gospels, Matthew covers the life and ministry of Jesus, including extraordinary miracles, supernatural teaching, and the unfolding mission of God. The Sermon on the Mount from chapters 5-7 is regarded as the greatest sermon ever taught and its radical teaching is often quoted by Christians and non-Christians alike. Today, however, many evangelicals do not even know about the last words spoken by Jesus before His ascension, which is important for us all to know to make disciples of all nations and fulfill His Commission.
