Bible Reading Plan 2025



October 2025 – Joshua and Judges

The Book of Joshua provides an overview of the military campaigns to conquer the land area that God had promised Israel. Following the exodus from Egypt and the subsequent forty years of the wilderness wanderings, the newly formed nation is now poised to enter the Promised Land, conquer the inhabitants, and occupy the territory (Got Questions). We are introduced to characters such as Rahab who had heard of the mighty hand of God working miracles and who later joined the people of Israel. The story of Jericho stands out as an example of God leading His people through Joshua and giving them the land promised to their forefathers. The Book of Judges, however, covers a much broader history of Israel during this time of being formed into a nation. Over a long period, they are given judges to rule over them yet frequently falling into sin and God allowing them to be conquered by their enemies. A particular verse stands out that feels eerily familiar to the world we are living in today and the need for repentance in our land: "In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes" (Judges 21:25).
