## September 2025 - The Mission of God

The Word of God, from Genesis to Revelation, encompasses God's overarching mission of His glory among all nations. The book of Acts begins the new era of the church age with the ascension of Jesus and the coming of the Holy Spirit. The apostles are now given the mandate to teach, preach, and heal as the early church emerges in Jerusalem. As a result of Peter's rousing sermon in Acts 2, three thousand people come to faith and are baptized, thus igniting a movement of God. For a period of time, the early church can grow with little opposition until heavy persecution comes down, causing a dispersion of believers to other places that need the Gospel. Paul's conversion is highly significant as this further spreads the message to the Gentiles and eventually the ends of the earth. We can learn much about how God works and moves in the world by thoroughly studying this book, all the while knowing "the wind blows where it wishes," as it is with the Spirit of God.
