1. Why do you think there is an importance put on reading the words of this prophecy aloud? Will you take time this week to read some Scripture aloud?
2. What is the difference between hearing the words and keeping the words?
3. What is an example of the words we should keep?
4. Why should knowing that the “time is near” affect the way we live? In what ways should it affect us? What are some things you are doing because you know time is short? What things would you like to do more of?
5. Why was it important that John mentioned each person of the Trinity in this passage?
6. What do you think the “seven spirits represent?”
7. What is the difference between Jesus being raised from the dead in comparison to Lazarus (John 11:11-44), Jairus’ daughter (Mark 5:22-24, 35-43) or others that was raised from the dead?
8. Why doesn’t our obedience or our disobedience change how much God loves us?
9. Why is it important that Jesus released us from the bondage of our sins?
10. What did priests do in the Old Testament? How can we apply this to Revelation 20:6 which says, “they will be priests of God?”
11. How were clouds used in the Bible to represent God’s presence? How were these clouds described? How does this change your perspective of the phrase “Jesus is coming with the clouds?”
12. What do you think the phrase “every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him...” means? Does it mean just those alive when He returns, everyone from all time, or something else? Why?
13. What do you think your response will be at seeing Jesus’ returning? One of praise? One of mourning? One of regret? Why?
